## Wheatland Montessori Pre-Kindergarten

Welcome to our Montessori Pre-Kindergarten program. We offer a nurturing and enriching program, based on the Montessori philosophy, for children ages three and four.





"The Montessori Method of education, developed by Dr. Maria Montessori, is a child-centered educational approach based on scientific observations of children from birth to adulthood. Dr. Montessori's method has been time tested, with over 100 years of success in diverse cultures throughout the world. It is a view of the child as one who is naturally eager for knowledge and capable of initiating learning in a supportive, thoughtfully prepared learning environment. It is an approach that values the human spirit and the development of the whole child—physical, social, emotional, cognitive." - American Montessori Society

Our Pre-Kindergarten children learn through a process of exploration and self-discovery which focuses on nurturing a natural curiosity and love of learning in a social environment. The students are guided to work at their own pace as they learn to develop social-emotional and daily living skills. They also have opportunities to explore the senses, math, language, science, nature, geography, music, art & dramatic play. Our program includes child-directed, small group and individualized instruction through the use of hands-on tactile learning materials.

## Registration Requirements

The Wheatland Montessori
Pre-Kindergarten program is a
pay-per-use program and is not
publicly funded. Tuition is \$1,250 for the
year. Parents are able to break up





payments into a monthly fee (\$125). A one time Montessori material fee (\$25) will also need to be paid in order for your child to participate.

- Completed registration and FOIP form
- If parents have chosen to pay the \$1250 yearly fee by breaking it into monthly payments, the \$125 per month, need to be paid on https://www.schoolcashonline.com/ (due by the 1st of every month)
- Wheatland Elementary School's Pre-K program is officially a licensed facility.
   Our program will continue to offer the same high-quality early childhood education, but eligible families will be able to receive a \$125 per month government grant to offset the cost.
  - This means eligible families will be able to access our program for free after receiving the grant.

- A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit/supply fee is required at the time of registration either by cash or cheque.
- Monthly installments may be made by submitting post-dated cheques for the first of each month or with our online portal (<a href="https://wheatland.ghsd75.ca/">https://wheatland.ghsd75.ca/</a>). If payment is not received by the 1st of each month, your child's placement may be up for review.

All of the above must be submitted to ensure your child has a space in the program. It is very important to inform the school if any of your contact information changes.

#### Times and Dates:

Monday/Wednesday 8:30-11:30 am

-or-

Tuesday/Thursday 8:30-11:30 am or 12:30-3:30pm

The above class configurations may change, as they are dependent upon enrollment numbers.





We will be having a staggered entry to help ensure a smooth transition for children. This also provides an opportunity for your child to have more 1-1 time with the classroom teacher on their first day. Your child's staggered start date will be posted on their Seesaw Journal.

We will follow the Golden Hills School Division calendar. In the case of a holiday Monday, the Monday & Wednesday program will run Wednesday & Friday on those weeks.

## Location, Entry, and Dismissal:

Our classroom is located in the school portable on the northwest corner of our building. Parking is available along Strathford Blvd. or in the parent parking lot. Please do not park in the staff parking lot. Our Pre-K staff will greet families at the NVV Eco doors (portable entrance) after the 8:25 bell. If you arrive early, please allow our K-6 students time to enter the building first as their bell rings at 8:20am. You may briefly enter the school (boot room only) to help your child organize their belongings. Please sign your child in & out each day on the sheet provided, say a quick goodbye and exit through the NVV Eco doors. Pre-k families may not use the front entrance of the school during arrival or pick-up time without administrator approval. This arrival and dismissal procedure is only for pre-k families. K-6 parents may not enter through student doors. Please be prompt for pick-up. If someone else will be dropping off or picking up your child, please let your child's teacher know in advance.

## Volunteer Policy:

Volunteering in the Pre-K classroom is optional. All parent volunteers must have the following documentation turned into the school office. New volunteer paperwork is not required each year. The school office keeps copies on file for future reference.

- An RCMP Criminal Record Check that can be obtained at 500 VVestlake Rd, Strathmore, AB or calling (403) 934-3968 for more information.
- An Intervention Record Check (IRC) that can be obtained by emailing cs-ircrequest@gov.ab.ca until September 1, 2022. After September 1, 2022, you will be required to contact the Strathmore Children's Services Office (403) 934-1706 to request an IRC.

#### Child Wellness:

In order to maintain the wellbeing of your child, other children and our staff, we ask our families to follow these quidelines:

- All children must be at least 3 years of age by Sept. 1st and completely
   potty-trained prior to the first day of school. If your child is not ready, please
   contact our Pre-K coordinator at leanne.pinel@ghsd75.ca to request approval for
   a later start date.
- If a child should become ill while at school, parents will be contacted immediately, and if they can not be reached, the emergency contact may be asked to pick the child up from school.

## Pre-Kindergarten Staff:

Our Pre-Kindergarten program will be led under the guidance of our certified teacher Mrs. Leanne Pinel who has been working with Wheatland Montessori since the program first began with a K-2 class in 2005.



Mrs. Pinel holds a Bachelor of Education degree from the University of Saskatchewan, Stage 2 Early Childhood certification in Montessori Theory and Methodology and Level 3 Alberta Early Childhood Certification.. She has loved working in Montessori environments for the past 22 years. In addition to her role as our Pre-K Coordinator, Mrs. Pinel is our Montessori grade K/1 teacher.



Mrs. Lisa Carless is our lead teacher in the pre-kindergarten morning program. She has been working with the VVheatland Montessori pre-kindergarten program since it began in 2015... She has a diploma in Rehabilitation Services and has enjoyed 32 years of working with families and their children in a variety of learning environments.



Mrs. Sheila Boutet is our lead teacher in the pre-kindergarten afternoon program. Mrs. Boutet has a passion for working with children and has training in early childhood and youth care through Mount Royal College. She has been on staff at Wheatland Elementary since 2016 and has enjoyed working in our Montessori pre-k classroom since 2017. Mrs. Boutet will also continue her role to provide speech and occupational therapy support for our morning classes.

## Program Structure:

### Discovery Time-

As the students arrive they are invited to choose from an assortment of tray and shelf activities in our prepared classroom environment. They are encouraged to tidy up their materials and move on to other activities as they desire. Activities may include practical life trays, sensorial, language, math and culture materials. Play dough, painting, toys, puzzles, books, coloring, and dramatic play items are also available. During Discovery Time the classroom teacher and assistants

will rotate and work with individual or small groups of children. Children will be guided toward the Montessori academic

material as they seem interested and ready.



Students tidy up their activities and meet for some group activities. These activities may include calendar tasks, songs, music, movement games, story time or planned

teacher lessons related to a specific topic or theme.





#### Snack Time-

Students visit the school washrooms and wash their hands before returning to the classroom to enjoy a healthy snack Please limit snacks to 2 or 3 nutritious items. Items should be easy for your child to open

independently. We encourage healthy eating, please limit sugary treats..



#### Social Emotional Learning-

We spend a little time each day focusing on Social Emotional Learning lessons and activities. This helps children gain knowledge about feelings and getting along with others. Social Emotional Learning is the process in which children are able to acknowledge and recognize the emotions of others, develop empathy, make good decisions, establish friendships, and handle challenges and situations effectively. These are very important skills to teach at the Pre-Kindergarten level before they enter the K-6 school program.

## School Supplies & Child Belongings:

In order to promote healthy living and nutrition, please send a spill proof water bottle and a healthy snack each day. All students require an indoor pair of running shoes, which can be left at school. Please keep a complete change of clothing for your child, in a plastic zip-lock bag, in their backpack just in case of an accident.

It is important that all belongings are clearly labeled with your child's name.

All other student supplies will be provided. A classroom craft supply wish list is available from the classroom teacher if you would like to donate any items.

Please avoid sending toys and special belongings, unless requested by the teacher for classroom activities or events. We can not be responsible for lost or damaged items.

## Birthdays:

We like to celebrate your child's special day with a Montessori Birthday Circle. Your child will be guided through a demonstration of how the earth rotates around the sun by holding a globe and walking 4-5 laps around a candle. We will share a photo of this special celebration with you on Seesaw. Please let the teachers know if you would like to send in cupcakes or a special treat on your child's birthday.

## Photographs:

Pre-Kindergarten students are invited to attend the VVheatland School picture day to receive an individual photo. This date will be announced early in the fall.

#### Seesaw Communication:

# Seesaw sign up is our preferred method for the majority of home school communication.

Please watch for teacher notes, reminders and photos of your child to be posted on your child's private Seesaw Journal. You may download, print or save Seesaw information and/or photos of your child. Group photos may be posted on occasion once F.O.I.P. parent permission has been granted. We ask that



families do not share any of our group photos beyond Seesaw. As a schoolwide initiative we are trying to reduce the amount of photocopying. To support this initiative, the majority of Pre-K notices and parent information will be posted digitally on Seesaw.
